

































NFL Mock Draft

1		MYLES GARRETT	DE	TEXAS A&M	Explosive off the edge, too quick for guards down the middle. Can't miss prospect.
2		JAMAL ADAMS	S	LSU	Comfortable in the box or at the line of scrimmage, playmaker and a tone setter.
3		MARSHON LATTIMORE	CB	OHIO ST.	Size and speed and athleticism, just what you need playing Aaron Rodgers and Stafford 4 times a year.
4		LEONARD FOURNETTE	RB	LSU	A Tom Coughlin pick, Jags get more physical on offence as they try to assist the struggling Bortles.
5		MALIK HOOKER	S	OHIO ST.	The Titans could go WR here but they desperately need a playmaker in the secondary.
6		MIKE WILLIAMS	WR	CLEMSON	A surprise but the Jets are desperate for receiver help. Marshall is gone. Is Decker the same player?
7		SOLOMON THOMAS	DE	STANFORD	Versatile can play inside and outside. Pass rush is everything in the AFC West.
8		JOHNATHAN ALLEN	DE	ALABAMA	Practically a steal at 8, the Panthers need to get back to being a dominant defence.
9		GAREON CONLEY	CB	OHIO ST.	The Bengals love a rangy corner. Conley has excellent size and length.
10		DESHAUN WATSON	QB	CLEMSON	Still not sold on Tyrod? Bills get their QB of the future who they hope can topple the Patriots.
11		CHRISTIAN MCCAFFERY	RB	STANFORD	Runner, Receiver, Returner. The Saints need defensive help but can't pass on this talent.
12		MITCHELL TRUBISKY	QB	N. CAROLINA	The Browns get their man. Believeland is back.
13		COREY DAVIS	WR	W. MICHIGAN	Excellent route runner, has size and speed, true successor to Larry Fitz?
14		JOHN ROSS	WR	WASHINGTON	Despite questions about his health the Eagles take their speed guy opposite Alshon Jeffery.
15		TAKKARIST MCKINLEY	DE	UCLA	The Colts have quietly improved on defence during free agency. They continue rebuilding here.
16		DEREK BARNETT	DE	TENNESSEE	Barnett can play anywhere on the line. He may have the highest ceiling of any pass rusher in the draft.
17		HAASON REDDICK	LB	TEMPLE	Stock has risen widely during offseason, can play on or off the line of scrimmage dependant on need.
18		OJ HOWARD	TE	ALABAMA	Exotic smash mouth continues here. Titans could wreak havoc with their two tight ends sets next year.
19		JABRILL PEPPERS	S	MICHIGAN	Polarising but dynamic prospect, could go as high as the top 10 as low as 32. Shouldn't slip further.
20		REUBEN FOSTER	LB	ALABAMA	Off field issues mean another defensive stud falls to Denver in the draft. Covers well and hits hard.
21		MARLON HUMPHREY	CB	ALABAMA	You better have a strong secondary if you're going to beat the Packers in the NFC North.
22		KEVIN KING	CB	WASHINGTON	King can contribute straight away in Miami. But can they dethrone the Patriots?
23		GARETT BOLLES	OT	UTAH	The Giants need to keep Eli clean if they want to go further in the playoffs.
24		ADOREE JACKSON	CB	USC	Room for growth as a CB but has tremendous upside will contribute on special teams immediately.
25		PATRICK MAHOMES	QB	TEXAS TECH	Thought to have the highest upside of any prospect in the draft. Incredible arm talent, needs time.
26		RYAN RAMCZYK	OT	WISCONSIN	Russel Wilson got hurt last year and the Seahawks won't win without him. Protecting Wilson is vital.
27		CHARLES HARRIS	OLB	MISSOURI	KC have lost a lot of talent on the line this offseason, they need to re-up to maintain an area of strength.
28		TJ WATT	OLB	WISCONSIN	Rumoured to be a Jerry Jones favourite all offseason. The Cowboys are desperate for a pass rush.
29		DAVID NJOKU	TE	MIAMI	The signing of Bennett means Njoku has time to grow. Incredibly athletic, could become a favourite target.
30		JARRAD DAVIS	LB	FLORIDA	This is an area the Steelers need to get younger and more athletic. A Steeler if I've ever seen one.
31		TACO CHARLTON	DE	MICHIGAN	Considered a boom or bust prospect. The Falcons can't afford a Super Bowl hangover.
32		TRE'DAVIOUS WHITE	CB	LSU	The Saint's consider improving defence a top priority. Drew Brees can't put up 40 forever.

Round 1, pick 20: Reuben Foster, LB, Alabama - Dominant playmaker, will start straight away.

Round 2, pick 51: Evan Engram, TE, Ole Miss - Less TE more big bodied receiver, think Jordan Reed.

Round 3, pick 82: Sidney Jones, CB, Washington - 1st round talent before tearing achilles. May not fall this far.

Round 3, pick 101: Antonio Garcia, T, Troy - Should compete for starting job, high upside.

Round 4, pick 126: Elijah Qualls, DT, Washington - Joins former teammate Jones, will be in the rotation.

Round 5, pick 177: Jamaal Williams, RB, BYU - Physical runner, lacks vision. Must contribute on special teams.

Round 6, pick 203: Jayon Brown, LB, UCLA - Jumped out at me at the combine. Will be in the rotation.

Round 7, pick 238: Garrett Fugate, QB Central Missouri - Heralded as this year's Trevor Siemain.

Round 7, pick 252: Chris Muller, G, Rutgers - We need depth on the O line.

Round 7, pick 253: Quincy Adeboyejo, WR, Ole Miss - Mr Irrelevant is coming to Denver.
